You'll develop a strong foundation in garment creation through hands-on learning and close mentorship, gaining technical expertise, creative confidence, and collaboration and communication skills. From construction, draping, and patternmaking to hand drawing and digital illustration, every course is designed to prepare you for the real world. By graduation, you'll have the skills and fluency to take a garment from concept to runway with intention, precision, and your own distinctive point of view.

HOW YOU'LL WORK

As juniors and seniors, students work collaboratively in fast-paced fashion cycles, developing original collections based on real-world design directions and industry-standard briefs reflective of professional practice. You'll work side-by-side with Otis faculty throughout the year and gain exposure

to a range of professional perspectives through the renowned Legacy Mentor Program, where top designers like Mike Amiri challenge you to stretch your skills, elevate your craft, and think like a professional.

Sustainability is woven into the curriculum—from upcycling and zero-waste techniques to working with next-generation materials and cutting-edge digital tools. Partnerships with top brands like Amiri, J.Crew, Nike, Patagonia, Jonathan Simkhai, Vince, and Vuori bring real expectations, real critiques, and real-world relevance to each project.

You'll build key skills including:

- **Design & Build Garments**—develop concepts into finished pieces through construction, draping, textiles and patternmaking
- **Create Digital 3D Spaces**—visualize and simulate garments using CLO 3D, Adobe applications, and innovative AI platforms
- **Illustrate & Communicate Ideas**—express your design vision through hand drawing, digital illustration, and professional presentations
- **Develop Specialized Industry Collaborations**—shape creative direction, materials, fabrication, and finishing while collaborating and designing responsibly
