In Product Design at Otis College, you'll learn to turn ideas into thoughtful experiences, products, objects, and systems that shape everyday life. The program emphasizes adaptability, strong 2D and 3D design skills, and problem-solving, preparing you to work across today's evolving industries.

You'll move through the full product development process, from research and ideation to prototyping, testing, manufacturing, and launching, while building a portfolio grounded in creativity, functionality, and human-centered thinking.

Working across materials and processes including wood, metal, textiles, plastics, ceramics, digital tools, and emerging technologies, you'll develop the ability to think critically about sustainability, user needs, ethics, and cultural impact. By graduation, you will be prepared not only to design products, but to create meaningful experiences.

You'll work in Otis's advanced shops, labs, and studios, including wood and metal shops, 3D model and fabrication facilities, ceramics, lighting, photography, and video. Beginning sophomore year, students have access to a dedicated workspace that supports focused, individual, and collaborative design work.

Whether you're designing consumer products, apparel and accessories, exploring mobility and sustainability, creating furniture and spaces, or launching your own brand, the program supports a diverse range of ambitions, design fields, and career paths.
